



## 2026 AUCKLAND MĀORI & PASIFIKA TRADES TRAINING (MPTT) SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION SHEET

The Māori & Pasifika Trades Training (MPTT) Scholarship entitles you to: free tuition fees for this academic year (**excludes short/block courses**). You will be assigned to an MPTT Navigator' who will provide opportunities such as; Work Readiness workshops & discussions that will help prepare your transition into employment.

### Eligibility criteria to apply for the MPTT Scholarship:

- You must identify that you are of New Zealand Māori and/or, of South Pacific **descent** of the South Pacific regions i.e. Republic of Fiji, The Kingdom of Tonga, Samoa, the Cook Islands, Solomon Islands, Vanuatu, Tuvalu, Nauru, Niue, Kiribati and atolls of Tokelau. **It is very important that you identify** as being of New Zealand Māori and/or of South Pacific descent when you apply for the programme that you wish to study in. If you do not identify as New Zealand Māori and/or of South Pacific descent on your programme of study application, you will need to provide evidence to support your ethnicity when you complete this MPTT Scholarship application **and**
- You must be a NZ Citizen or NZ Permanent Resident or regarded as a Domestic student or an Australian Citizen or Australian Permanent Residence currently residing in New Zealand **and**
- You must be aged between 16-40 years of age at the start of your programme at MIT
- You are enrolled in a programme at MIT Te Pukenga which is approved for Māori & Pasifika Trades Training Scholarship funding. Please visit the MIT website [www.manukau.ac.nz](http://www.manukau.ac.nz) for a list of the approved MPTT programmes

All MPTT Scholarship recipients are required to **adhere** to the following terms and conditions of this Scholarship

- **All Scholarship applicants may be required to attend an interview unless otherwise advised. Applicants can bring a support person/s with them to the interview.**
- Regular attendance to your classes throughout the duration of your course
- Attend **ALL** "Work-Ready" preparation programme workshops.
- Maintain regular contact with your MPTT Navigator services
- Attendance and participation in Regional MPTTA events if and when required
- Fully consent to MPTT staff informing the person I've nominated to act as my Recommended Sponsor and Navigator of my academic progress when required.
